Notes for JAMES LESLIE, CAPT 15TH REG OF FOOT.:

James Leslie was a Captain in the 15th Regiment of Foot, he served under Amherst at Louisberg, and Wolfe at Quebec, and was twice wounded in the American war. He then resigned his commission, returned to Scotland and married Elizabeth Stuart and settled at Kair Kincardineshire where he died on 1 April 1791. James Leslie was possibly mentioned in James Wolfe's will. This may have been another Capt Leslie from Ireland, which was made on the eve of the taking of Quebec and his own death, 12 September 1759, where he was apparently left one hundred guineas to buy swords and rings, in remembrance of his friend. (The Capt James Leslie who was mentioned in Wolfe's will, may have been Capt James Leslie of Courtmacherry Ireland) At Fordoun there is a small monument erected to the memory of James Leslie of the 15th Reg of Foot by his son James Leslie Mer of Montreal.
